- 1976 Hire first female Associate, Paula Calimafde
- 1985 Move offices to 4800 Hampden Lane in Bethesda
- 1987 Hope Eastman joins the firm and brings Employment Law
- Merge with Goldstein, Blitz & Rosenberg to form Paley, Rothman, Goldstein, Rosenberg & Cooper and add Bankruptcy and Creditor's Rights

- 1992 Mark Goldstein becomes President of the Bar Association of Montgomery County
- 1998 Dan Hodin joins the firm and brings Presidential Title
- 2001 Merge with Eig & Schwartz and add Ethics and International Tax
- Glenn Cooper becomes President of the Bar Association of Montgomery County
- 2003 Changes name to Paley, Rothman, Goldstein, Rosenberg, Eig & Cooper
- 2004 Art House joins the firm and adds Science & Technology practice
- 2006 Former Principal, Honorable Wendelin Lipp becomes a Judge for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Maryland
- 2010 Steve Paley, co-founder, passes away
